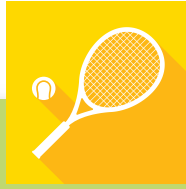

2024 SUCCESSES

There are hundreds of teens in Kern County who want to join their high school tennis teams, but their families are not able to afford the equipment they need to get on the court. Our goal is to remove that financial barrier. In 2024, KCTA served a record number of low-income local teens, providing them with racquets, shoes, backpacks, and clothing free of charge. With the support of generous donors, we also provided over 7,000 court hours of professional instruction, hosted clinics for over 40 high school coaches, and welcomed over 500 student athletes at the BTOpen and WTO high school nights.

Our success is driven by over 3,600 volunteer hours, strong local partnerships, and generous sponsors. One such partnership with Bank of America provided financial literacy training to more than 200 students in local athletics. It is an important life skill that many student athletes do not learn at home or in school. Our sponsors, many of whom donate through Give Big Kern, earned us the #1 rank in Education and Youth Development and #14 overall out of 138 non-profits. With their support, we are changing lives by increasing participation, elevating competition, and fostering lifelong tennis players.

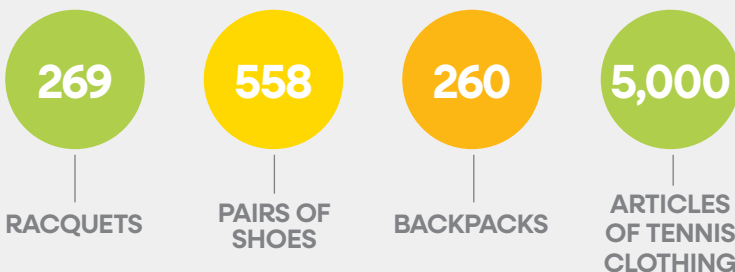

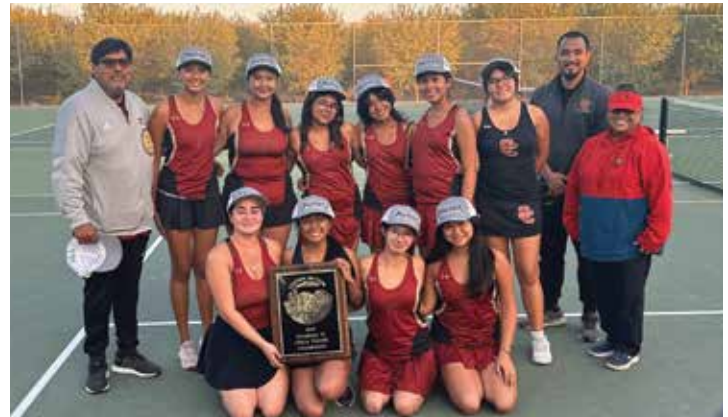
THEY NOW HAVE WHAT THEY NEED
